Red Data Status (IUCN - 15 Oct 2012) All birds not indicated with another code are **LC**

LC = Least Concern

NT = Near Threatened

VU = Vulnerable

EN = Endangered

CR = Critically Endangered

The current Red Data Book of South Africa (2000) is in the process of revision.

Endemism is indicated for SOUTH AFRICA and not southern Africa as in most fieldguides.

RR = Reporting rate - the number of SABAP2 atlas cards reflecting the bird in relation to the total number (n) of cards for the Swartland area (n=1121)

RR gives an indication of the probability to see the bird within the Swartland Municipality as indicated on the map on the Swartland Tourism Website.
